WORLD MEETING OF FAMILIES: Throughout Ireland, preparations are well under way for the World Meeting of Families which will take place in Dublin from 21st - 26th August 2018. This event is held every three years and is a time when families from all over the world gather to pray, and to celebrate marriage and the family as a cornerstone of our lives, of society and of the Church. The meeting is at the invitation of Pope Francis and is organised by the newly created Vatican department of Laity, Family and Life. Pope Francis will be visiting Ireland during those days.



The theme of the meeting, chosen by the Holy Father, is **the Gospel of the Family**: **Joy for the World.** This is closely related to the themes of his 2016 exhortation *Amoris Laetitiae* (The Joy of Love)

The icon has now started to travel to each diocese in Ireland to encourage reflection and prayer as part of the journey of preparation. People are invited to write petitions which will be brought to the meeting in August.
