



FR CHRIS WRITES: As is traditional this Newsletter covers the 2 weeks of the Christmas Period. As you will see there are various times for you to come to Mass over this Christmas period.. I remind people that Christmas is celebrated over 8 days finishing with Mary the Mother of God next Sunday on January 1st .Why not come to Mass during the Christmas period?


Sadly we have lost some Parishioners in the last week:
