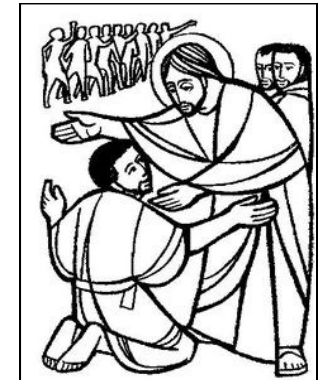

Support with your love prisoners and their families and friends, prison staff and all who care. Heal those who have been wounded by the actions of others, especially the victims of crime. You are invited to attend the Catholic Safeguarding Standards Agency (CSSA) National Safeguarding Training via webinar. They will be delivered by Sebastian Carro, the National Training Coordinator for CSSA. The National Training Learning Portal will also provide these courses later this year, which can be completed online for those who are unable to attend the initial webinar training, further details will be released once this is available. In this first phase of training, Parish Safeguarding Representatives and volunteers who require a DBS for their role can access these courses.
