SCHOOL ADMISSIONS TO ST JOSEPH'S ACADEMY (Foundation Year) - Children born between 01/09/2018 and 31/08/2019 The deadline for submitting your application for a school place is 15th January 2023. Application forms are available on the Leicestershire Local Authority Addmissions website. When applying to a Catholic school, if you wish your child to be considered and ranked under a faith criterion you must also complete a supplementary information form, and return this form to **St Joseph's** by the deadline. (Please contact the School Office on 01858 465359 to obtain a form). You MUST also include the supporting evidence as required eg baptism certificate (photocopies acceptable). Failure to supply the required supporting evidence will mean your child is ranked is a lower criterion which may affect your chance of a place. If you do not have the required evidence please contact the parish where your child was baptised for a copy certificate in good time.

NEW CATECHIST FORMATION COURSE: There is a new formation course for catechists which begins in January. It is designed to build confidence and knowledge to live this wonderful ministry.
